

ORDER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING  
IN-PERSON VISITATION BETWEEN  
JUVENILE JUSTICE YOUTH IN  
PLACEMENT AND THEIR PARENTS,  
GUARDIANS, SIBLINGS AND  
RELATIVES

Pursuant to its authority under Welfare and Institutions Code ("WIC") sections 202 and 727, and at the request of the Nevada County Probation Department (the Probation Department), the Court hereby makes the following Orders regarding the children/youth who are subject to the jurisdiction of the juvenile court and who are in out-of-home placement, effective immediately upon issuance. This Order will expire at 5:00 p.m. on Friday, May 15, 2020.

1. Due to the public health emergency caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and the proclamation of a state of emergency by federal, state, and local officials, as well as the shelter-in-place orders issued by the Nevada County Health Officer, this Juvenile Court hereby grants the Probation Department to suspend all court-ordered in-person visitation for children/youth who are subject to the jurisdiction of this Court and their relatives/non-relative extended family members. Before suspending court-ordered in-person visitation, the Probation Department will assess each case to determine whether it is possible to

conduct in-person visitation by exercising the precautions of distancing and protective barrier protections ordered by the Nevada County Health Officer, without compromising the health and safety of the children and their families. The purpose of this Order, which includes supervision of and transportation to and from visits, is to protect the health and safety of the children/youth, their families, and the general public.

2. The Probation Department is hereby authorized to substitute computer/cell phone assisted video conferencing and/or telephonic contact in place of court-ordered in-person visitation whenever feasible. The Probation Department is also authorized to delegate the supervision of any such computer/cell phone assisted video conferencing and/or phone contact to a child/youth's caregiver or other available responsible adult whenever possible, given the staffing shortage and the drain on resources caused by this health emergency.
3. Except as otherwise provided herein, this Order is not intended to replace, nullify, or conflict with any existing policies of the Nevada County Probation Department, or any other public or private agency.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
