The seminar will cover the following topics:

- 1) A brief overview of California's probate system including assets transfers on death and conservatorships to allow health and financial decisions to be made in the event of incapacity;
- 2) A review of California's statutory form health care directive, power of attorney, and will;
- 3) An explanation of some of the gaps in the statutory forms and suggestions for additions that can make the forms more comprehensive; and
- 4) An overview of what decisions must involve a physician, and when it would be advisable to seek the advice of an attorney.

This program is geared to individuals who are looking for general information about estate planning or who seek an inexpensive way to prepare a very basic estate plan. While options for probate avoidance will be discussed, the tools promulgated by the Legislature that will be distributed at this program are not probate avoidance tools.
